1. Individual updates on projects allocated funding

1.1 Maitland List of Crossover ramps

The following ramps have been completed;

10. Corner Elizabeth Street and Walter Street (North West Corner)

11. Corner Elizabeth Street & Walter Street (North East Corner)

12. Corner Elizabeth & Walter Street (South West Corner)

24. Corner Gardiner Terrace & Walter Street (Eastern Corner)

Update required from Nick Hoskin on;

25. Corner Gardiner Terrace & Kilkeran Terrace

1.2 Yorketown Council Office Building – Council committed \$8,000 for the replacement of the entrance ramp – project currently deferred pending further investigation to what is included in the quote. Update from Roger Brooks.

2. Other Matters Arising

2.1 Stansbury - Investigate installing a ramp near the Blue Lime Café facing the Dalrymple Hotel -- Nick Hoskin to provide an update.

2.2 Ardrossan - The footpath near the caravan park has been washed out twice due to recent weather conditions – works to be undertaken in the 2017/2018 financial year. Nick Hoskin to provide update.

2.3 Stansbury – Build up of gravel on the corner of Ceres Street. – Nick Hoskin to provide and update.

2.4 Maitland – Arty Glazbrook advised that the drains near the Uniting Church are possibly blocked, as after heavy rains the water lays around and covers a good part of the road – Nick Hoskin advised that a contractor would undertake the works - update from Nick Hoskin.

2.5 Edithburgh – The following access ramps upgrade has been completed.

1. Giles Street and Blanche Street

2. South Terrace and O'Halloran Parade

3. Thomas Street and Blanche Street

4. Henry Street and Anstey Terrace

The following ramps require upgrading – Nick Hoskin to provide update.

1. George and Blanche Street

2. South Terrace and Blanche Street

3. George Street and Anstey Terrace

2.6 Minlaton Main Street - Investigate the lack of coordinating handrails, footpaths and ramps along the mains street precinct – Nick Hoskin and Roger Brooks to provide an update.

2.7 Price Tennis club – correspondence was sent to the Price Tennis club in May 2017, requesting they consider a 50% financial contribution for the installation of the 24 metre ramp, estimated to cost \$3,300. Council has not received a reply.
