Access Advisory Working Party meeting held on 3rd February 2017.

Please be advised that **Items 2.7** and **2.8** from **Other Matters Arising** of the 3rd February 2017 Agenda, were omitted from the 3rd February 2017 Minutes.

An amendment to include the following addition for the minuted **Items 2.7** and **2.8** is set out below.

- 2.7 Minlaton - Investigate the installation of an access ramp on the southern side of the South Terrace opposite the doctors surgery – The level of the footpath and the amount of driveways that enter through the footpath may make installation impractical - Nick Hoskin to investigate and provide update.**

The Party discussed that the installation of ramps opposite the doctors surgery would compromise premium car parking. If ramps were to be installed, the party agreed they should be located on the corners of the footpath.

- 2.8 Yorketown – Investigate installation of an access ramp at The Telecentre Yorketown. – Nick Hoskin to provide an update.**

The Party discussed that the installation of a ramp directly in front of the Telecentre would compromise much needed car parking. Remove this Item from the Agenda.

1.6 MATTERS ARISING FROM MINUTES

1. Individual updates on projects allocated funding

- 1.1 Port Victoria – installation of access ramp opposite the crossover next to Port Victoria Hotel – Contractors have been engaged – update from Nick Hoskin.

- 1.2 Maitland - A list of Maitland crossover ramps was received and the Party committed \$4000 to the project. The Maitland Progress Association has confirmed the following four (4) locations as suitable for the installation of access ramps. There are too many to do in one budget period, therefore ramps will be installed in order of necessity. Nick Hoskin advised that the works have been listed into the Works Programme to be completed this financial year – update from Nick Hoskin

10. Corner Elizabeth Street and Walter Street (North West Corner)

11. Corner Elizabeth Street & Walter Street (North East Corner)

12. Corner Elizabeth & Walter Street (South West Corner)

24. Corner Gardiner Terrace & Walter Street (Eastern Corner)

And if budget permits

25. Corner Gardiner Terrace & Kilkeran Terrace

- 1.3 Port Vincent - crossovers along the Main Street. Five (5) crossovers have been identified for replacement – Council has committed \$4000 for the upgrade - update from Nick Hoskin.

- 1.4 Yorketown – Council committed \$8,000 for the replacement of the entrance ramp to the Yorketown Council Building – update from Nick Hoskin.

2. Other Matters Arising

- 2.1 CYP Library requested funding to enable easier wheel chair access to the library entrance. Nick Hoskin advised that line marking could be completed to establish a disabled car park area, with the addition of signage and the removal of the bitumen hump. The project could be completed for approximately \$400 – update from Nick Hoskin
- 2.2 Stansbury - Investigate installing a ramp near the Blue Lime Café facing the Dalrymple Hotel – The Party discussed that traffic management and loss of car parking needs to be considered and discussion with local police should be undertaken - Nick Hoskin to provide an update.
- 2.3 Ardrossan - The footpath near the caravan park has been washed out twice due to recent weather conditions – Nick Hoskin to provide and update.
- 2.4 Stansbury – Build up of gravel on the corner of Ceres Street. Nick Hosking advised that a permanent solution is being sought. – update from Nick Hoskin.
- 2.5 Maitland – Arty Glazbrook advised that the drains near the Uniting Church a possibly blocked as after heavy rains the water lays around and covers a good part of the road – Nick Hoskin to provide an update.
- 2.6 Edithburgh – John Edwards presented a list of access ramps identified for either installation or upgrades in the 2017/2018 budget.

1. Giles Street and Blanche Street – currently no ramp

2. George Street and Blanche Street – two old and unsafe ramps in need of replacement

3. South Terrace and O'Halloran Parade – new one required, west of the power pole

4. South Terrace and Blanche Street – very old and needs replacing

5. Thomas Street and Blanche Street – (west side) very old and needs replacing

6. Henry Street and Anstey Terrace – needs replacing

John Edwards also advised the need for access ramps either side of the anchor – displayed on Edith Street - Nick Hoskin to provide an update.

ITEM 2 CORRESPONDENCE

2.1 Price Tennis club are seeking financial assistance for the construction of a paved or sealed disabled pathway from the road reserve to the clubrooms. The Tennis club has a regular spectator who is wheel chair bound and a ramp would provide much needed access. Nick Hoskin has inspected the site and estimates the construction of a 24 metre long ramp to be \$3,300.

2.2 Stansbury Bowling Club are seeking 50% financial contribution of \$574.00 to purchase portable, folding, lightweight ramps. The ramps would be placed at each corner of the bowling rink across a 250mm ditch to provide disability access to the playing surface.
