Dear Felice

Thank you for granting me an extension for time to respond to your letter dated 18 July 2017.

Upon review of our original correspondence sent to the District Council of Yorke Peninsula on 17 May 2017 relating to this matter and our request for the Council to undertake a Section 270 internal review, I am writing to add the following point for your consideration;

We are concerned the elected members had predetermined an outcome of this matter prior to the two community consultations. The basis for our concern is that there was a strong percentage of the community that were opposed to the land revocation in the first consultation stage – this was evident from the numerous submissions made to council. The second community consultation illustrated the same outcome. It appeared to us the consultations were undertaken as a “token effort” with a view for the council to have “ticked the boxes” when all along we believe a decision was reached by the elected members before the consultation was completed.
