TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

KEY DATES

Opening Date

1. Online Registrations Open Friday, 20 November 2021. ALL Open Exhibition Categories.

Closing Dates

2. *Early Bird* Online Entries must be received by Wednesday 20 January 2021; and
3. ALL Online Entries must be received by Wednesday 17 February 2021.

Artwork Drop-off Dates

1. Adelaide artwork drop-offs to Newmarch Gallery, 128 Prospect Road by Friday, 26 March 2021; and
2. Ardrossan (painting and fine art), Yorketown (photography) and Edithburgh (sculpture) artwork drop-offs will occur on Saturday, 27 March 2021.

Opening Night

1. The invite only, Exhibition Opening Night is Thursday 1 April 2021, 7.30pm for an 8.00pm start.

FEES AND REGISTRATION

1. Open Entry fees are \$15.00 GST Inc for each work.
2. *Early Bird* (month prior to final closing date) Entry fees are \$12.00 GST inc. for each work.
3. In recognition of the support shown by all 2020 Registered Participants, in 2021 artists get to enter four (4) artworks for the registration price of three (3) artworks. A 25% Saving!
4. Artist registrations and entry fee payments are Online. If a person, other than the artist completes the Online Entry Form, they must state on the Entry Form that they have the authority from the artist to do so.
5. Registration must be entered on a single, Online Entry Form unless otherwise arranged in advance of the closing date.
6. All entry fees are compulsory and will not be refunded under normal circumstances, however some exceptions may apply ie where the Working Party enacts its right to not accept / display an artist's work.
7. Receipts will be issued by email as part of the online payment process.

AUTHORIZATION

1. All entries must be the original uncopied work of the exhibiting artist.
2. The YP Art Exhibition and competition is open to anyone (professional, amateur or emerging artists).



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3. In 2021, artwork entered must not have been exhibited competitively (excluding local agricultural shows) within the Yorke Peninsula Council area in the last three years – up from the usual two years.
4. Entrants warrant, to the best of their knowledge, there is no cultural, religious, legal or other reason that prevents the submitted image from being exhibited, published or reproduced.

CONDITIONS OF DISPLAY

1. COVID Safe Practices and Plans, will apply at all 2021 YP Art Exhibition locations.
2. An artist may enter a maximum of three (3) works, or four (4) artworks – see FEES and REGISTRATIONS Point 3.
3. As Exhibition space is at a premium, the Working Party reserves the right not to display all (multiple) entries submitted by the one artist. Where practical, the artist will be contacted to make the selection of which artwork(s) to withdraw from the exhibit.
4. All works must be for sale for the duration of the Exhibition.
5. All works have a minimum sale price of \$100 per artwork.
6. Frames and mountings must be sound, unsullied and fit for purpose.
7. Each work must clearly show the artist's name and address; the title of the art work, the medium; the relevant judging category and the price on the back - top right hand side.
 - a. Whilst every care is taken, all entries are submitted at the total risk of the artist.
 - b. The artist indemnifies the committee of the Yorke Peninsula Art Exhibition against any claim, loss or damage of whatever nature or cause however occurring and whether directly or indirectly relating to entered works or their delivery or display.
8. No painting or photography entry is to exceed 1.5 square metres in size including the frame.
9. No sculpture entry is to exceed 2 metres x 2 metres. Oversize or excessively heavy entries cannot be accepted.
10. Artworks must be delivered with dry materials and with secure hanging devices attached or will not be accepted for inclusion in the Exhibition. Preferred hanging devices are firmly and securely attached (stapled or screwed-in) hanging wire or D rings – *adhesive plastic fixings cannot be accepted*.
11. Artwork must not contain any material or content that is infringing, threatening, false, misleading, abusive, harassing, defamatory, vulgar, pornographic or otherwise objectionable.
12. In the event that any artwork is deemed unsuitable or does not meet the competition criteria, the competition organisers reserve the right to withdraw it from the Exhibition and competition.

COPYRIGHT

1. By completing and signing an Entry Form to enter any work/s in the YP Art Exhibition, the entrant gives permission for the Committee to reproduce images of any work submitted for the purpose of publicity, promotion of the Exhibition, education, preparation of the catalogue and sale of items without payment of fee, royalty or other remuneration.

JUDGING AND DISPLAY

1. All judges' decisions will be final and no correspondence or discussion will be entered into.
2. All entries will be eligible for judging in the Open Section of the relevant category.
3. In addition to the Terms and Conditions of Entry, the following Judging criteria applies:



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- a. subject matter/idea
 - b. does it make the most of its medium (use the medium to its advantage)
 - c. level of expertise displayed
 - d. composition, design elements, colour
 - e. an overall a strong, compelling work / image
4. The Committee reserves the right not to award a prize in any category of the competition if, in the opinion of the judge/s, no work is of sufficient merit.

PAINTING - ARDROSSAN TOWN HALL

1. Artists whose principal residence is in the Yorke Peninsula Council area will also be eligible to enter the 'Verna Lock Memorial award for Local Artists'.
2. An artist may enter painting or printmaking in this Category.
3. Stretched canvas is considered framed but must have rigid and adequate cross members.
4. All fittings for hanging wires must be in the top third of the frame. Paintings must be supplied with wire, not cord.
5. All entries must include:
 - a. a title
 - b. a photograph of the painting/print (for inclusion in the catalogue)
 - c. a brief 'Artist Statement' (max. 100 words) that includes a description of the painting/print and any other art mediums used. The Artist Statement will accompany the work on display.
6. Painting/print will be displayed at the Ardrossan Town Hall over the Easter long weekend. Open Good Friday, Easter Saturday and Sunday from 10:00am to 2:00pm. Not open Monday 5 April.
7. Painting/print will be displayed at the Ardrossan Town Hall over the 2021 Easter long weekend.
8. Open Good Friday, Easter Saturday and Sunday from 9.30am to 4:00pm. Open Monday 5 April from 9.30am to 12 noon.

Delivery and Collection of Paintings

1. Personal delivery of paintings – Saturday, 27 March 2021 between 9:30am and 4:00pm at the Ardrossan Town Hall.
2. Collection of works at Ardrossan Town Hall (sold – by customer and unsold – by artist) on Monday, 5 April from noon to 3.00pm.

PHOTOGRAPHY - YORKETOWN TOWN HALL

1. We encourage photographic entries that reflect or capture the local Yorke Peninsula region.
2. Entries must not contain trademarks or copyright material owed whole or in part by a third party or violate any persons' moral rights or rights to privacy.
3. The image must not contain any identifiable information of the entrant.
 - a. images submitted with watermarks or branding on them will not be accepted
 - b. where there is an identifiable person in an image submitted, the entrant is responsible for obtaining a signed *Model Release* to provide to the Committee if requested. (A Model Release means a release signed by or on behalf of any person identifiable in the image).
4. The image must not plagiarise the work of any other person.



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5. All entries must include:
 - a. a title
 - b. a photograph of the photograph (for inclusion in the catalogue)
 - c. a brief 'Artist Statement' (max. 100 words) that includes a description of the photograph and any other art mediums used. The Artist Statement will accompany the work on display.
6. Photography will be displayed at the Yorketown Town Hall over the Easter long weekend. Open Good Friday, Easter Saturday and Sunday from 10:00am to 2:00pm. Not open Monday 5 April.

Delivery and Collection of Photography

1. Personal delivery of photography – Saturday, 27 March 2021 between 10.00am and 3:00pm at the Yorketown Town Hall.
2. Collection of works at Yorketown Town Hall (sold – by customer and unsold – by artist) – Sunday, 4 April, from 2.00pm to 4.00pm. Not open Monday 5 April.

SCULPTURE – EDITHBURGH INSTITUTE

1. Where one sculptural artwork has multiple elements, the total area must not exceed 2m x 2m.
2. Sculpture to be free standing or self-supporting. Please indicate your preference for plinth or floor space on the entry form.
 - a. protection mats must be provided by the artist when required to safeguard the wooden floors at the Exhibition space.
3. If it is essential for your sculpture to be hung, it is the responsibility of the artist to provide free standing, secure and approved hanging devices.
4. All decisions pertaining to the display of the sculptures is at the discretion of the competition organiser.
5. All entries must include:
 - a. a title
 - b. a photograph of the sculpture (for inclusion in the catalogue)
 - c. a brief 'Artist Statement' (max. 100 words) that includes a description of the photograph and any other art mediums used. The Artist Statement will accompany the work on display.
6. Sculpture will be displayed at the Edithburgh Institute over the Easter long weekend. Open Good Friday, Easter Saturday and Sunday from 10:00am to 2:00pm. Not open Monday 5 April.

Delivery and Collection of Sculpture

1. Personal delivery of sculpture – Saturday, 27 March 2021 between 10:00am and 3:00pm at the Edithburgh Institute.
2. Collection of works at Edithburgh Institute (sold – by customer and unsold – by artist) – Sunday, 4 April, between 2:00pm and 4:00pm. Not open Monday 5 April.



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AWARDS

1. All entries are eligible for judging in the Open Section of the relevant category.
2. The Verna Lock Memorial Award is open to local painting artists only who reside in the Yorke Peninsula Council district.
3. Each work of art can only be eligible for one major prize (excluding the People's Choice).
4. Major prize finalists will be notified (by mobile phone as reasonably possible) prior to Opening Night.
5. 2021 Exhibition Winners will be announced at the Yorke Peninsula Exhibition Opening event to be held in the Ardrossan Town Hall on **Thursday 1 April 2021**.
 - a. doors open from 7.30pm with formalities commencing at 8.00pm.
6. The People's Choice award winner's votes will be tallied and announced at the end of the Exhibition. The winning artist will be notified by mobile phone as reasonably and quickly as possible.

PAYMENT AND COMMISSION

1. Yorke Peninsula Council will act as Agent for the purpose of the 2021 YP Art Exhibition.
2. A commission of 20% (+GST) will apply to all works of art sold during the Exhibition.
7. Full payment of sale proceeds to artists will be paid by cheque, and processed on or before Thursday 22 April 2021.
 - a. artists will be subsequently invoiced for the 20% (+GST) Commission component of the artwork sale, for payment by the artist to Council within 30 days.
