ITEM 3 CORRESPONDENCE

Seasonal closure of Flaherty's beach to vehicles

The Working Party discussed the request for a seasonal closure from Point Turton to the Flaherty's beach access point. This request aligns with the recommendation in the Coastal Management Strategy.

"Coasting around Yorke" Grant application

Correspondence has been received that the application by Landscape SA Northern and Yorke, of which Council is a partner, has not been successful, however the Minister for Environment has encourage resubmission under the next round of Landscape Priority Funds.

4.1 Update on progress of Section Three: Council Border (Federation Park) to Hickey's Point

Deb provided an update on the progress of Section Three, including consultation with community groups and status of surveys and mapping.

4.2 Outcome of Internal Risk Assessment and Coast Protection Board site visit at Tiparra Rocks

Stephen outlined the management options as discussed with the Coast Protection Board during their site visit. Measures include fencing the edge, signage and access management. The Coast Protection staff were agreeable to the recommendations made.

4.3 Progress of Local Roads and Community Infrastructure Program – Coastal Management Strategy projects

Letitia provided a status update for Phase 1 and Phase 2.

The Working Party are pleased with the number of recommendations from the Strategy that are being implemented with this funding.

4.4 Progress of Landscape SA Northern and Yorke / Legatus Coastal Management Action Plan grants

Letitia provided an overview of the weed control and revegetation works at three priority areas.

Again, the Working Party are thankful that grant funding is achieving the aims of the Strategy.
