## YP Council Access Advisory Working Party

### INTRODUCTION

The Tiddy Widdy Beach Progress Association (TWBPA) committee and general community are in support of the proposal for the creation of compacted gravel pathways through the Tiddy Widdy Beach Southern Reserve to provide access for individuals with physical disability. This proposal is supported with the aim to improve community inclusion for every person who wishes to access and participate in leisure and social activities within the local public recreational reserve.

### PROPOSAL

Over recent years, the recreational and social opportunities for individuals with physical disability have been enhanced through YP Council support for the installation of a disability access swing and a picnic table structure designed for access by people who use a wheelchair. There has also been previous support to upgrade the TWB Southern Reserve toilet facility to include disability access features.

The issue of access to easily get to these great recreational resources within the TWB Southern Reserve remains and unfortunately limits the use by individuals who have physical disability. The current uneven and undulating ground and slippery surfaces that must be traversed to reach these resources results in reduced access and use by those with limited mobility, particularly by persons who are dependent on a walking aid, mobility aid or frame or wheelchair. Currently, during wet weather, the park toilet facility is not safely accessible.

It is strongly supported by the TWB community that creation of compacted gravel pathways to enable access through the park, to the community shelter and to the toilet would improve safe access to the existing park resources. In turn, this would facilitate participation by a broader representation of our whole community, enhancing and supporting social inclusion, participation and quality of life by all persons who wish to use the park and to join social and community events held there.

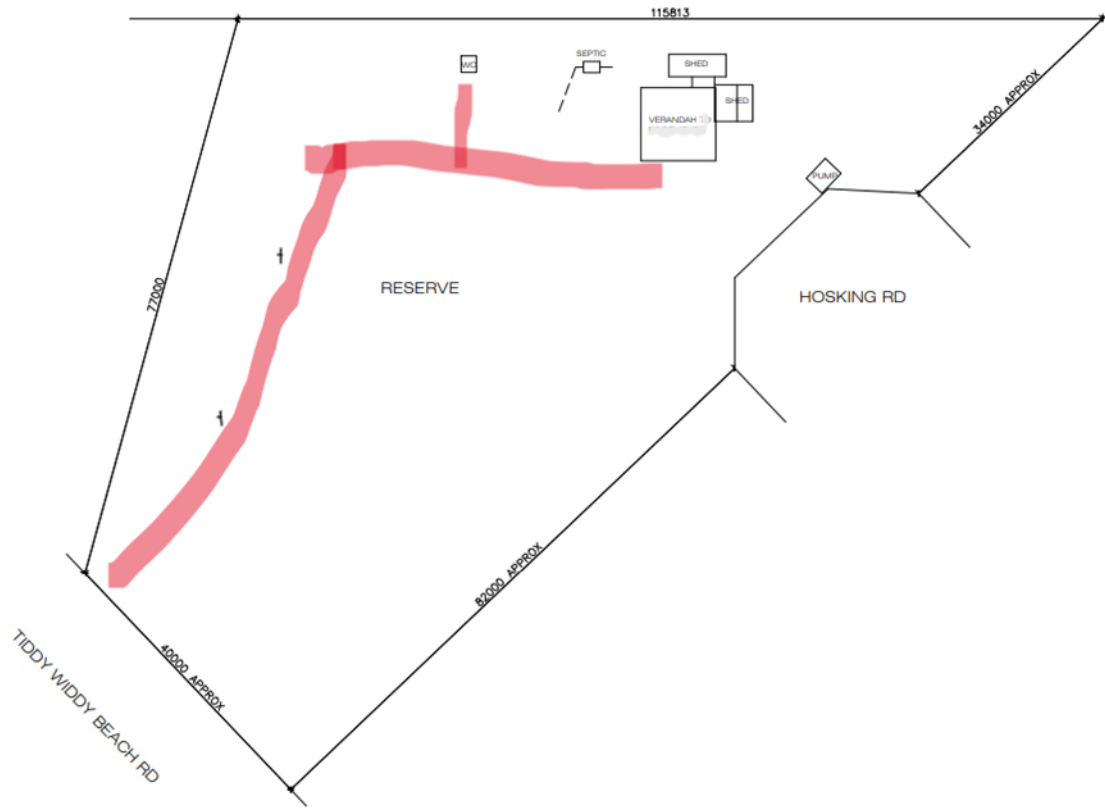


Fig. 2 Schematic Plan View of Proposed Access Pathway
