#### 1.6 MATTERS ARISING FROM MINUTES

#### 1. Individual updates on projects allocated funding

#### 1.1 Port Victoria - Installation of Handrails, Information Pergola

#### 1.2 Access ramp – Corner Ceres Street, Stansbury

\$1,850 was committed to relocate and install an access ramp on the corner of Ceres Street, Stansbury.

Nick Hoskin advised a contractor has been engaged.

#### **ITEM 2 CORRESPONDENCE**

Correspondence 23/10342 received 27 January 2023 from Tiddy Widdy Beach Progress Association (TWBPA) requesting financial assistance to install a designated dolomite pathway in the Tiddy Widdy Beach Southern Reserve. The pathway would provide accessibility to the disabled accessible table and chair setting, toilet and other aspects of the reserve. A quote of \$1,760 (including GST) has been obtained and TWBPA advise they are willing to make a 10% contribution towards the project.

Discussion ensued and the Working Party advised that dolomite was an unsuitable material to use for a disability access pathway and that concrete or paving would be more practical and as would reduce requirement for maintenance in the long term. Given concrete/paving would be a costly alternative, it was suggested by Cr Carruthers and Cr Headon that the TWBPA obtain quotes and consider applying for a Council community grant. The Working Party would in future consider contributing towards the project if TWBPA can secure majority of the funding to undertake the project.

### **ITEM 3 GENERAL BUSINESS**

John Edwards acknowledged the Progress Association members who were in attendance for the meeting. John proposed the installation of a pedestrian crossing from the Uniting Church to the Gum Flat Rest Area, Main Street, Minlaton. Roger advised this project has been discussed in the past however it has not had support from the Department of Infrastructure. John requested the Elected Members pursue discussions the Corporate Management Team on the matter.

Cr Headon advised of some tactile indicators on access ramps in the Port Clinton area are sinking below the level of the ramp. Cr Headon to submit a CSR for the ramps needing attention. Roger suggested that access ramps need to be audited to assess for maintenance. Nick Hoskin to discuss with Director of Assets and Infrastructure to undertake audit.

Heather Shepley advised the Corny Point Progress Association have engaged contractors for the upgrade of the entrance area to the museum which the Working Party committed funds for.
