1.1 Minlaton Town Hall Proposed Access Ramp

\$19,885 was committed for the construction of an access ramp at the rear entrance of the Minlaton Town Hall.

\$1,000 was committed for the installation of an access ramp at the entrance of the Memorial Garden and for improvements to the Pump Track entrance located in Ardrossan.
