Conditions of Entry 2018

*Artwork entered must not have been exhibited competitively (excluding local agricultural shows) within the Yorke Peninsula Council area in the last two years

Terms of Entry

- All entries must be accompanied by a signed Entry Form. If a person other than the artist signs the Entry Form he/she must have authority from the artist. Entry forms must be posted to or delivered to Yorke Peninsula Council c/- Art Exhibition PO Box 57 Maitland SA 5573. Entries must be received by Thursday 18th February 5pm.
- 2. All works must be for sale for the duration of the exhibition.
- 3. An artist may enter a maximum of five (5) works. They must be entered on a single Entry Form.
- 4. Each work must clearly show the artist's name and address; the title of the art work, the medium; the relevant judging category/ies and the price on the back top right hand side. If the artist intends to use Wheare Transport offer to return unsold images to the Adelaide depot, please note on the back of the painting.
- All entries are submitted at the total risk of the artist. The artist indemnifies the committee of the Yorke Peninsula Art Exhibition against any claim, loss or damage of whatever nature or cause however occurring and whether directly or indirectly relating to entered works or their delivery or display.
- 6. By completing and signing an Entry Form to enter any work/s in the 2017 YP Art Exhibition, the entrant gives permission for the Committee to reproduce any work submitted for the purpose of publicity, promotion of the exhibition, education, preparation of the catalogue and sale of paintings without payment of fee, royalty or other remuneration.
- 7. All entries must be the original photograph produced entirely by the entrant. It must not contain trademarks or copyright material owed whole or in part by a third party or violate any persons' moral rights or rights to privacy.
- 8. The entrant warrants, to the best of their knowledge, there is no cultural, religious, legal or other reason that prevents the submitted image from being exhibited, published or reproduced.
- 9. The image must not contain any identifiable information of the entrant. Images submitted with watermarks or branding on them will not be considered for judging.
- 10. Where there is an identifiable person in an image submitted, the entrant is responsible for obtaining a signed Model Release to provide to the Committee if requested. (A Model Release means a release signed by or on behalf of any person identifiable in the image).
- 11. The image must not contain any material or content that is infringing, threatening, false, misleading, abusive, harassing, defamatory, vulgar, pornographic or otherwise objectionable.
- 12. The image must not plagiarise the work of any other person.
- 13. The Committee reserves the right in its sole discretion to remove the image if the Committee has reason to believe that any of these terms have been breached.

Entry Fees

- 14. Entry fees are \$8 GST Inc for each work less than 1 square metre in size (including the frame) or \$15.00 GST Inc for each work larger than 1 square metre in size (including the frame). No entry is to exceed 1.5 square metres in size including the frame. Oversize entries will be rejected.
- 15. All entry fees are compulsory and will not be refunded under any circumstances.
- 16. Receipts will not be posted unless specially requested.

Judging and Display

- 17. All judges' decisions will be final and no correspondence or discussion will be entered into.
- 18. All entries will be eligible for judging in the Open Section.
- 19. Artists whose principal residence is in the Yorke Peninsula Council area will also be eligible to enter Section B the Verna Lock Memorial award for Local Artists.
- 20. The Committee reserves the right to withhold any exhibit from the exhibition.
- 21. The Committee reserves the right not to award a prize in any category of the competition if, in the opinion of the judge/s, no work is of sufficient merit.
- 22. All entries must be suitably framed and ready for hanging with the wire tensioned so that the hanging point is 75mm below the centre top of the frame with flush D hangers (not screw eyes). Stretchered canvas is considered framed but must have rigid and adequate cross members. All fittings for hanging wires must be in the top third of the frame. Paintings must be supplied with wire, not cord.

23. The following entries will NOT BE ACCEPTED:

a. Wet paintings

b. Prints including linocuts, monoprints, stencils

- c. Photographs
- d. Mosaics
- e. Collages
- f. Oversize paintings

g. Paintings with unacceptable framing or hanging

- h. Sculpture
- i. Beaten metal work
- j. Digitally enhanced art work
- k. "Worked" prints
- I. Etchings

m. Pokerwork and pyrography

- n. Textile art works
- o. Bark arrangements
- p. Plaster relief work
- q. Unprotected tempera
- r. 3D, Porcelain & ceramics
- s. Damaged on arrival

Awards

- 24. All entries are eligible for judging in the Open Section. Section B is only available to Artists residing in the Yorke Peninsula Council district.
- 25. Each work can only be eligible for one major prize (excluding the People's Choice).
- 26. Major prize winners will be notified prior to Opening Night and announced at the Official Opening in the Ardrossan Town Hall on Wednesday 23rd March 2016 commencing at 8.00pm, doors open from 7.30pm
- 27. The People's Choice award winner will be announced at approximately 4.00pm on Sunday 27th March 2016.

Commission

- 28. A commission of 20% (+GST) will be charged on all exhibits sold during the exhibition.
- 29. Payment of sale proceeds will be processed on or before Monday 11th April 2016.

Receipt and Collection of Paintings

- 30. Sponsors Wheare Transport have offered free transport of paintings to Ardrossan leaving from their Adelaide depot from Thursday 10th March through to Thursday 17th March and returning to the Adelaide depot on Thursday 31st March. Secure packaging, insurance and liability is the sole responsibility of the artist. Their depot is at Shed 5, 9 Greenfields Drive, Greenfields 5107. Phone contact 08 8837 3083.
