On 28 February 2018, Bluff Beach Community Group wrote to Council requesting to change the name of the land known as Allotment 23, CT 5863, Folio 105, Bluff Beach, to Bluff Beach Community Reserve.

Council's Property Tenure Officer has looked into the request and has advised the Bluff Beach Community Group that Council is currently reviewing its Community Land Register and Community Land Management Plans.

This parcel of Council land will be allocated to a specific management plan, which best suits the purpose for which the land is held by Council.

Before a Community Land Register or Community Land Management Plan Register can be adopted by Council it must go out for public consultation. Once Council has undertaken this process, the parcel of land at Bluff Beach can be suitably categorised.
