 Green Waste Bin (green lid)

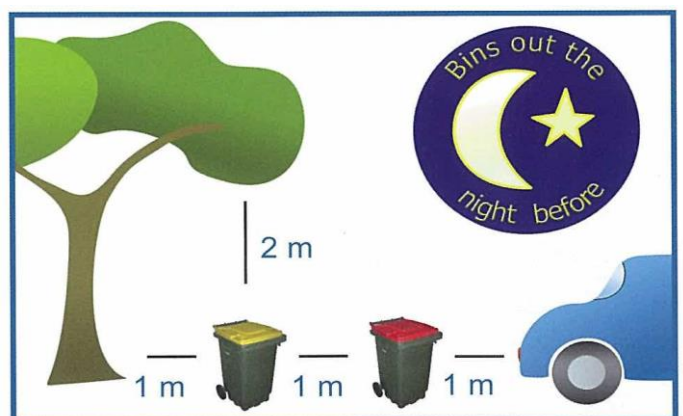
