IS084 WASTE COLLECTION INFORMATION

In October 2008, Council implemented a new waste and recycling service. This service provides a 3-bin collection system for residential properties within identified townships and a 2-bin system for businesses and residential properties within the rural sector.

Council's Waste & Recycling Contractor, SITA Australia, collects the weekly waste (140L red lid) and fortnightly recycling (240L yellow lid) bins in addition to the monthly Garden Organics (240L green lid) bins.

To ensure that these collection services operate efficiently, Council seeks your assistance.

PLEASE PUT YOUR MGB

- on the footpath as close as possible to the kerb or the road edge
- **FACING THE STREET** ie wheels and handle **TOWARDS YOUR HOUSE**
- with the lid completely closed, clear of parked cars or trees and at least 300mm away from any other bin or obstruction
- out the night before collection
- Rural Property Owners: at nominated collection point and 3m from carriageway

PLEASE DO NOT

- put inappropriate material into your bin (refer to your information booklet to assist in determining the appropriate bin for your waste)
- overload your bin, the bin lift is set of a maximum load of 80kg
- compact the rubbish in your bin - if it sticks in the bin - it stays in the bin!

BINS MAY NOT BE COLLECTED IF

- the lid is OPEN OR
- the bin is overloaded OR
- the bin is placed incorrectly

If you are a non-resident, or you rent/lease/loan your residential property, you may wish consider making an arrangement with your neighbour/s about the placing and retrieval of your bin if the residence will be vacant on collection day.

New garden organics (green 240L) bins may be purchased from any Council office at a cost of \$70.00 or may be purchased new or second hand from any alternative supplier.

If your waste (red lid, 140L) bin or recycling (yellow lid, 240L) bin is stolen, you will need to make a police report. Once you have a police report number, you can purchase a new bin from any Council Office at a cost of \$55 for a waste bin and/or \$70 for a recycling bin.
