

## Yorke Peninsula Camping Locations

Numerous approved bush camping sites exist throughout the Yorke Peninsula and are situated at some of the most beautiful scenic coastal areas, which are accessible by conventional vehicles. Details are listed in the Camping Guide to South Australia which is available from Tourism SA.

All camping locations require a permit for camping.

No fees are required to be paid at the following camping locations; The Gap, The Bamboos, Tiparra Rocks, Wauraltee Beach and Barkers Rocks, however a camping permit is still required.

## The Gap

Located on the north west coast of the Peninsula, 15km north of Balgowan. Access via Balgowan.

- Camping permit required (no camping fees apply)
- Beach launch boat ramp.
- BYO water & firewood.
- Gas/fuel stoves preferred.
- Environmental toilet facilities.



## The Bamboos

Located on the north west coast of the peninsula, 12km north of Balgowan. Access via Balgowan.

- Camping permit required (no camping fees apply)
- · Beach launch boat.
- · BYO water & firewood.
- Gas/fuel stoves preferred.



## **Tiparra Rocks**

Located on the north west coast of the peninsula, 8km north of Balgowan. Access via Balgowan.

- Camping permit required (no camping fees apply)
- Beach launch boat.
- · BYO water & firewood.
- Gas/fuel stoves preferred.



### Wauraltee Beach

Located on the north west coast of the peninsula, 17km south of Port Victoria on the Wauraltee Beach Road.

- Camping permit required (no camping fees apply)
- BYO water & firewood.



## **Barkers Rocks**

Located on the north west coast of the peninsula, 12km northwest of Minlaton on the Barkers Rocks Road.

- Camping permit required (no camping fees apply)
- BYO water & firewood.



## **Burners Beach**

Located on the north coast of the foot on Point Souttar Road, 12km west of Point Turton.

- · Camping permit required.
- · Natural boat ramp.
- BYO water & firewood.
- Gas/fuel stoves preferred.
- Environmental toilet facilities.



Located on the west coast of the foot. 6km south west of Corny Point. Access via West Coast Road.

Camping permited on coastal reserve stretching from South Berry Bay carpark along west Coast Road through to Point Annie Road.

- Camping permit required.
- Close to popular fishing and surf spots.
- BYO water & firewood.
- · Gas/fuel stoves preferred.

Camping not permitted in Berry Bay car park areas.

Gravel Bay Area

Located on the west coast of the foot. 6km south west of Corny Point. Access via West Coast Road.

Camping permited on coastal reserve stretching from South Berry Bay carpark along west Coast Road through to Point Annie Road.

- · Camping permit required.
- Close to popular fishing and surf spots.
- BYO water & firewood.
- · Gas/fuel stoves preferred.

Camping not permitted in Berry Bay car park areas.



#### **Swincers Rocks**

Located on the upper west coast of the foot on Wurlie Road, 13km south west of Corny Point.

- · Camping permit required.
- BYO water & firewood.
- · Gas/fuel stoves preferred.



## **Gleesons Landing**

Located on the west coast of the foot. 16km south west of Corny Point. Access off Corny Point to Marion Bay Road.

- Camping permit required.
- Natural boat ramp.
- BYO water & firewood.
- Gas/fuel stoves preferred.
- · Environmental toilet facilities.

#### Foul Bay

Located on the south coast of the peninsula. 39km south west of Warooka. Access via Happy Valley Road.

- · Camping permit required.
- BYO water & firewood.
- · Gas/fuel stoves preferred.



Located on the coast coast of the peninsula. 13km south of Warooka. Access via Sturt Bay Road.

- · Camping permit required.
- BYO water & firewood.
- · Gas/fuel stoves preferred.



#### Mozzie Flat

Located on the south coast of the peninsula. 23km south of Warooka and 17km south of Yorketown. Access off Corny Point to Marion Bay Road.

- · Camping permit required.
- · BYO water & firewood.
- · Gas/fuel stoves preferred.



#### Kemp Bay

Located on the south coast of the peninsula. 13km south of Yorketown. Access off Diamond Lake Road.

- · Camping permit required.
- · Popular fishing spot.
- · BYO water & firewood.
- Gas/fuel stoves preferred.



#### Troubridge Hill

Located on the south coast of the peninsula. 19km south of Yorketown and 15km south west of Edithburgh. Access via South Coast Road.

Camping permited on coastal reserve stretching from Diamond Lake Road along South Coast Road and continuing along Troubridge Point Drive.

- · Camping permit required.
- Popular fishing spots.
- BYO water & firewood.
- Gas/fuel stoves preferred.

# Troubridge Hill Area

Located on the south coast of the peninsula. 19km south of Yorketown and 15km south west of Edithburgh. Access via South Coast Road.

Camping permited on coastal reserve stretching from Diamond Lake Road along South Coast Road and continuing along Troubridge Point Drive.

#### Goldsmith's Beach

Camping permited on coastal reserve stretching from Wattle Bay Road along South Coast Road and continuing along Troubridge Point Drive.

- Camping permit required.
- Popular fishing spots.
- BYO water & firewood.
- Gas/fuel stoves preferred.

# Goldsmith's Beach Area

Located on the south coast of the peninsula. 18km south east of Yorketown and 8km south west of Edithburgh. Access off South Coast Road from Edithburgh.

Camping permited on coastal reserve stretching from Wattle Bay Road along South Coast Road and continuing along Troubridge Point Drive.

- Camping permit required.
- Popular fishing spots.
- BYO water & firewood.
- Gas/fuel stoves preferred.
