I agree that while I have use of the cat trap from the Yorke Peninsula Council, I will obey the conditions of the Dog and Cat Management Act, 1995 in that:

- Any person who seizes an unidentified 'feral' cat must deliver it within twelve (12) hours to a Council Ranger (not to be left a Council Office unless directed by a Ranger) or an authorised person pursuant to the Dog & Cat Management Act. Identified cats must be released immediately. (i.e. cat wearing a collar or microchipped)
- The trap must not be used on any land or property without the consent of the occupier or owner of the land or property.

The following conditions will be followed:

- No person may interfere or remove the means by which a cat is identified.
- Please do not set traps between Thursday night and Saturday night as Council's officers will be unavailable to seize cats during the Friday, Saturday, Sunday period.
- A \$25 bond is payable on hire of trap, refundable on return within 7 days from initial hiring.
- Use of cat trap is for a period of 14 days. Traps are to be returned to Council in clean condition. Traps can be used for a longer period upon negotiation with Council.
- Use of cat traps will only occur within the YPC Council area.

Failure to comply with these Conditions may lead to subsequent action and fine.
