## SUCCESS WITH FUNDING FOR WALK THE YORKE

Council has been successful in securing nearly \$1.4 million from Round 4 of the Regional Development Australia Fund through the Federal Government, to fund 50% of the Walk the Yorke project. Stephen Goldsworthy's passion and determination to see his vision of a Walking Trail of some 500kms around the whole of the Council region has been realised.

This is an outstanding achievement and plans are in full swing to work out the timelines for implementation. Stephen will be responsible for Project Management and will be working alongside community groups and other key stakeholders to undertake community consultation and ensure the success of the project.

## DOG REGISTRATION AND MICROCHIPPING

Council has recently sent out reminder notices to all those dog owners that had dogs registered last financial year. These dogs need to be reregistered prior to 31st August otherwise the dog will be unregistered. There is a \$20 late payment fee if the dog is not reregistered by this date. All dogs over 3 months of age legally need to be registered

Council is very privileged and thankful to have the ongoing support of the Veterinary businesses that operate in our district. With the great support of Vet 2 You and YP Vets, during the month of August and September you are able to get your pets microchipped at any of their outlets for \$30, which is a huge discount on the normal price. Microchipping is an extremely reliable method of identification which greatly increases the chance of your pet being returned to you if it becomes lost.

A small microchip, about the size of a grain of rice is implanted under your pet's skin which has a unique number. The owner's details are recorded against this number on a central data base which can be accessed by Council Officers. Microchipping does not replace the legal need to register your dog.


